

MINUTES OF THE CONGREGATIONAL BUSINESS MEETING

April 28, 2019

Meeting commenced at 10:05 with an opening prayer by Pastor Stone.

1. Announcement that next Sunday will be Law Enforcement Sunday honoring those serving our community in Law Enforcement. A carry-in meal will follow with the church furnishing pulled pork. Chicken and side dishes will be brought by church members.
2. A summer intern from Ashland University, Cassidy Johansson, will be here May 25 for six weeks, ministering with the youth activities, camp, and as needed. A sign-up list will be available to help with her meals and lodging.
3. Camp on our church property will be June 3-7.
4. Pastors and Spouses Retreat will be held in the area May 14-17 with some activities here on our campus.
5. A new 5 year lease has been signed with Play and Grow Day Care.
6. The Survey Committee suggested that we consider a new name for our church for advertising and marketing purposes. This suggestion is not to change the legal name but to adopt a "doing business as" name that would be more understandable for our community. If anyone would like to submit a suggestion, let someone from the Executive Council or the Pastor know.
7. The church received a large donation, about 27,000. The Executive Council made the following recommendation: "\$15,000 be used to pay down the mortgage, about \$6,000 be used for a new air conditioner in Fellowship Hall, and the rest be used for marketing."
8. MSC to accept the recommendation of Executive Council.

Business meeting was adjourned at 10:15 and the worship service began
