Galatians 5:13-26

The danger of freedom

Freedom allows you to make choices, good and bad.

1 Corinthians 6:12; 10:23

Acts of the flesh

Sexual Immorality: sexual activity outside of marriage

Impurity: evil deeds and evil thoughts

Debauchery: following indecent passions and desires

Idolatry: giving anything equal or greater authority than God

Witchcraft: occult practices

Hatred: extreme dislike of others

Discord: quarreling with others, especially in the church

Jealousy: rivalry, envious of others' success

Fits of Rage: explosive anger

Selfish Ambition: illegitimate seeking power or position, putting self first

Dissensions: breaking the unity of Christian fellowship

Factions: division into cliques that destroy the unity of the church

Envy: wishing that the blessings of others were yours instead

Drunkenness: impairing your physical or mental control by alcohol or drugs

Orgies: excessive partying, involving alcohol, drugs, sex, etc.

Fruit of the Spirit

Love: treating others as you wish to be treated.

Joy: gratefully acknowledging God's blessings.

Peace: the trust that all is, and will be, well.

Forbearance: patiently putting up with others.

Kindness: to act with consideration of others.

Goodness: to do the right thing.

Faithfulness: completely trusting in God.

Gentleness: to not be harsh with others.

Self-control: resisting temptations.
